79, of Huntington, West Virginia passed away peacefully at Glasgow Health and Rehabilitation Center on April 16, 2021. Archie was born on October 8, 1941 in Huntington, son of the late Robert H. Johnson and Frances E. Steward.

Archie graduated from Douglass High School. He enlisted and served in the United States Army for six years in the early '70s. Archie was a steel mill worker at Connors Steel for 28 years, retiring in 2001.
