After graduating high school with honors, he attended Concord University in the fall of 2011. While at Concord University, he joined the fraternity of Tau Kappa Epsilon. After leaving Concord, he came back to Huntington and became employed with Home City Ice. In 2013, Devante decided to pursue another endeavor in his life and joined the United State Navy. He attended Naval boot camp in 2014 and after his completion, he was ordered to the Carrier Harry S. Truman in August 2014. During this time, he became a Religious Program Specialist 2 (RP2). Some of the qualifications that RP2 Marable achieved were Surface Warfare, Air Warfare and Information Pins. RP2 Marable also received the Naval Achievement Medal for his work throughout the 2015-2016 deployment. RP2 Marable participated in countless volunteering events which help lead the Truman to several volunteer awards such as the Bainbridge Award.
