Mr. Frank Nowlin, 86, of Huntington, WV, passed away Monday, January 26, 2009 at Mount Carmel East Hospital, Columbus, OH. He was born July 6, 1922, in Lynchburg, VA, the son of the late Nathaniel Nowlin and Beulah Nowlin Rogers. He was also preceded in death by his loving wife, Elizabeth Jefferson Nowlin and a brother, Robert Nowlin. He was a Veteran of World War II having served in the United States Navy and retired from the VA Medical Center after 30 years of service.
