He was one of six children born to William "Bill" and Rose Patton Miller. His only surviving sibling is Ronald Darius Miller of Flatwoods, KY. Two brothers, Edgar Miller and Harold Miller predeceased him. Two sisters, Wanda Hieneman and Judy Virgin have also gone before him.

Hershell was born in Greenup County, KY on September 09, 1932. His birthday is now known as "Hershell Miller Day" in Greenup County after Judge Executive Bobby Carpenter declared the day on his 80th birthday. He graduated from McKell High School in 1950. He was also a Kentucky Colonel. He was called to service his country in the US Army stationed in Bamberg, Germany and was discharged as a Corporal in 1955.

Hershell began working for the C&O Railroad in 1951 at its Raceland Car Shop. He retired in 1993, having attained the position of General Foreman. He counted his coworkers among his best friends. After all, he spent the most time with them.
