Isabel Bryan, 87, of Huntington, left this world to join her husband, Rev. Henry Bryan, on January 4, 2007. Funeral services will be held at 2 PM on Sunday, January 7th, at Lewis Memorial Baptist Church, with Dr. David B. Lemming officiating, interment will follow in Ridgelawn Memorial Park. Isabel was born on August 12, 1919, in Altoona, PA, daughter of the late Victoria and Alexander Abdallah. She was a graduate of Practical Bible College, in Binghamton, NY, where she met her husband.
