He retired from the U.S Army Corp of Engineers in 2004. Lyman was a member of the VFW Post 9926, American Legion Post 23, The Marine Corp League Detachment 1180, and was recently accepted in "The Sons of the American Revolution". He enjoyed spending time with his grandson, hunting, camping, fishing on the Cranberry River, his trips to Alaska, history, quiet time at his

hilltop getaway, had several invention patents, time spend with friends on Chestnut Ridge and Camp Desperation, American Revolutionary War reenactments where he portrayed the perfect image of an American frontiersman.
