



## Norma Jewel Mylar

June 11, 1920 - January 5, 2008

Norma Jewel Mylar, 87, of Jefferson City, died Saturday, Jan. 5, 2008, at Westphalia Retirement Center. She was born on June 11, 1920, in Hamlin, W.Va., the daughter of Will B. and Ollie Belle Moore Moore. She was married on Sept. 11, 1936, in Huntington, W.Va., to Charles Warren Mylar, Jr., who died on Oct. 31, 1985. An honor graduate of Huntington High School, Mrs. Mylar worked with her husband in the family business of Mylar's Inc., an insurance, license, and tax firm.
