Preston Clayborn Jr., 65, of Huntington, WV went to be with the Lord March 20, 2008 at home. He was born January 24, 1943 in Williamson, WV, the son of the late Preston Clayborn Sr., and Elizabeth Wells Clayborn. He was an active member of Calvary Missionary Church where he served as a Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, Bible Study Teacher, and was a spokesperson for the Mission Auxillary at Mariner's Nursing Home. He was also attending Tri-State Bible College until his health failed. Mr. Clayborn was a Cabell County Deputy Sheriff, a veteran of the U.S. Army where he served in Vietnam. He graduated from Marshall University with a degree in Business Administration, where he was a member of Kappa Alpha PSI Fraternity. He retired from Applied Card.
