Theodore Roosevelt (Ted) Wood, 89 of Huntington, WV., husband of Pauline Griffith Wood for 69 years, passed away from this life Monday February 13, 2006 in St. Mary's Medical Center. He was born April 26, 1916 in Leon, WV. A son of the late Mary Branham and Nathan Wood. He was a member of the Apostolic Life Cathedral for 58 years, where he served as a Trustee for 57 yrs and as Sunday School Superintendent for 37 years.
