Thomas graduated from Huntington High School in 1992. He attended West Liberty University and Marshall University where he majored in music.

Thomas loved music and played numerous instruments. His favorite instrument was the upright bass which he played in the Marshall University Orchestra. He graduated from Huntington Junior College with a degree in counseling and was certified as a peer recovery coach from Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery and was also issued 2 certifications as a peer recovery support specialist one from the West Virginia Certification Board for Addiction and Prevention Professionals, Inc., and one from Recovery Point. He utilized his degree and certifications to touch many lives. His passion was helping others and would give you the shirt off his back if needed.

Thomas was a member of God's House of Prayer and Praise where he played the drums. He was a DJ for WMUL for several years playing music for The Quiet Storm and The Gospel Music programs. He worked for Recovery Point, the Cabell County Health Department (QRT team), City Mission, H.A.W.K. and Family Services and Rehabilitation. He enjoyed working with people and helping them recover from addiction.

He is preceded in death by his father Thomas T. Hill and uncle Robert A. "Joe" Hill.
