Walter Reid Stuart, age 86, of Scott Depot, WV passed away peacefully with his family by his side on Friday, December 5th, 2025.

Reid was born May 26th, 1939 to Walter G. and Irene (Shephard) Stuart.

He grew up on the family farm near Gildford, Mt that was homesteaded by his dad's family in 1910.

Reid enlisted in the US Navy in 1956 and proudly served from 10/2/1956 to 10/2/1962.

He graduated from Northern Montana College in 1973.

Reid married the love of his life, Delia Irene Overcast on July 10, 1960 in Havre, MT. They raised 4 children, Boyd, Rachelle, Jill & Bruce, whom he was always so proud of. They lived in many towns throughout MT until moving to Valier, MT in 1976 where they lived until moving to Conrad, MT in 2005. They have lived the past 8 ½ years in Scott Depot, WV with their daughter because of his failing health.
