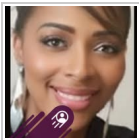
“ I would like to share a memory of Bill Whitney. When he and I first got together, we moved into his uncle's old house. We tried to get the electric turned on, but the wiring was outdated. We didn't have money for an electrician. Turned out, we didn't need one. Bill bought 5 oil lamps, a Coleman stove, a cooler and a car battery. We had light, we had a way to cook, and we had two hours of TV at night. He then would buy materials we needed to upgrade the wiring. He would leave me with detailed instructions for what I needed to do during the day to prep things, then when he got home from work, we worked side by side pulling wires from between the walls to the breaker box. Took us a year, but was the best year of our relationship! We were happy. The day we finished, the inspector failed it for one little thing that took Bill less than 10 min to fix, then we had electric. During this time, he treated me and my son Trea like gold. That is the man I miss.
